Park Hotel Tokyo will begin offering three new Artist Rooms simultaneously from March 12: "Windows and Chairs" (Artist: Kei Sugiyama), "SKY PARK" (Artist: Kyaraai), and "Ametuchi" (Artist: Ryoko Kaneta). Each room is decorated with artworks directly painted by the artists on the walls and ceilings, providing a unique art space.



An "Artist Room" at Park Hotel Tokyo is a guest room where artists have painted directly on the walls, featuring the following characteristics:

- **1. Unique Art Space:** Each room is decorated with paintings directly on the walls and ceilings by artists, offering the value of being a one-of-a-kind art piece.
- **2. Diverse Themes:** There are 47 artist rooms with themes aligned with Japanese aesthetics, such as "Castle," "Cherry Blossoms," and "Kabuki", each created by different artists. Four more rooms are currently in production.

Message from the Artist

Upon entering the room, I was immediately struck by the large windows. I envisioned a space where each wall had a window, so I designed the layout with that idea in mind. Windows serve as a bridge between the interior and the outside world, reflecting external landscapes. In that sense, paintings share a similar role by projecting scenes from the outside world.

I wanted to create a room where different landscapes could be enjoyed by placing window frames and paintings on each wall.

In my artwork, I often depict chairs as metaphors for people. By illustrating chairs or everyday objects, I aim to indirectly evoke the presence of their owners. For this room, I painted numerous chairs on the wall opposite the actual window, arranged like a group photo. At night, I hope the reflection of the chairs in the window will create a mysterious and intriguing atmosphere.

The name of this room, "Ametsuchi," means "Heaven and Earth." By layering the landscapes of the world we live in onto a space close to the sky-the hotel's top floor-I have created a space where sky and earth converge.

The large painted characters represent the personification of nature itself, while the smaller characters symbolize invisible elements such as the memories and traces left by the land. The room encapsulates various landscapes, including waterfalls flowing down rocky cliffs, mountains and Mount Fuji, the sun and moon, birds soaring through the sky, and the ocean waves lapping at your feet. I hope that your stay in this room allows you to experience the essence of Japan's natural beauty and the rich culture it has nurtured.





About Park Hotel Tokyo

Park Hotel Tokyo is a sister hotel of Shiba Park Hotel, which was established in 1948. Located on the 25th to 34th floors of the Shiodome Media Tower, it offers a spectacular view of Tokyo Tower and Mount Fuji. The hotel has 268 guest rooms, 47 of which are 'Artist Rooms' where artists have painted the walls. These 'Artist Rooms' are part of a project conceived to experience the aesthetic sense of Japan, and have won the Excellence Award in the Japan Tourism Awards. Over 400 pieces of art are displayed in the lobby and corridors. Art events such as tea ceremonies and painting experiences are also held.
